## Where are all the old AIRPEX programs?

One of the fun things about being the club's historian is that I never know what to expect when I attend a meeting. Almost every time someone comes over and tells me they've got a box in their trunk that I might be interested. It's usually very heavy. And unsorted. But that's what makes it interesting. To see the old newsletters, membership applications, and flotsam and jetsam that an 80+ year-old organization has held onto is a look back in time.

What I've done is collate a stack of AIRPEX programs. The club's first annual Philatelic Exhibition was Nov. 27-28, 1976, at the Dayton Convention Center. The event was designated DAYTON AIRPEX I. A special cachet honoring Prof. George de Bothezat, inventor of the first Army helicopter, was issued in conjunction with the show. The cachet sold for \$1.50. The Dayton Daily News described AIRPEX I as "unique," because it featured only Air Mail stamps and stamps honoring aviation.

We don't have a copy of the club's first AIRPEX program in our archives, so that's why I'm devoting this column to a request. Will every member reading this go on a treasure hunt for AIRPEX programs they have and are willing to donate?
